

ORDINANCE 599-04-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR/ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A WATER TOWER IMPROVEMENT CONTRACT WITH UTILITY SERVICES COMPANY, INC. FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMOVING TRIHALOMETHANES (THM) FROM SUCH TANK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the EPA has notified the Village that Trihalomethanes (THM) exceed the recommended quotas established by the EPA and may constitute a serious public health hazard.

Whereas, the Village has determined to enter into an Agreement with Utility Services Company to install a system to significantly reduce such by 60% Trihalomethanes (THM) under a water tower management contract which bypasses competitive bidding pursuant to R.C. 9.29, and which under any circumstances would constitute a public emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROAMING SHORES, OHIO:

Section 1: The Mayor/Administrator is hereby authorized to execute a five year water tank and management agreement with Utility Services Company, Inc at a cost of \$50,000.00 per year for the first three years, pursuant to the Master Agreement and the Scope of Work (SOW) agreement attached hereto as exhibits A and B.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Council determines this ordinance to be an emergency action for the health, welfare and benefit of the public for the reason that steps must be taken immediately to reduce any risk to the public drinking water; therefore this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
