

ORDINANCE 625-05-2015

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE MAYOR'S RECOMMENDATION THAT OFFICER DAN BENNETT IS HEREBY PROMOTED FROM A PATROL OFFICER TO SERGEANT, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, Officer Dan Bennett has served with distinction as a patrol officer for the Village of Roaming Shores for more than eighteen years, and has demonstrated competency, responsibility and leadership, particularly in the absence of the Chief during a recent illness.

Whereas, in recognition of his service, the Mayor has recommended that Officer Bennett be promoted from a Patrol Officer to Sergeant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio:

Section 1. Officer Dan Bennett is hereby promoted, effective immediately, from a Patrol Officer to Sergeant at the rate of \$18.85 per hour, including such benefits as are provided in the Village Personnel Code. A copy of his job description is attached hereto as exhibit A.

Section 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This ordinance is deemed to be an emergency for the health, safety and welfare of the Village, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
