Morning Star Drive Rehabilitation, Phase I-VI

Professionally Engineered for Safety, Durability, and Pleasant Use

Goal: To transform an adequate "country" road into a safer modern roadway with smooth, long lasting, asphalt concrete pavement and proper drainage.

Features:

- 22' wide road surface with 2' wide aggregate shoulders
- High grade polymer modified hot-mix asphalt concrete
- Provide new driveway aprons throughout the improvement
- Replace deteriorated driveway culverts with new storm sewer system
- New highly reflective traffic signage throughout the improvement
- Complete underdrain system

The total estimated cost for the improvement is \$1,500,000. After receiving financial assistance from the Ohio Public Works Commission, the projected local cost will be \$750,000. The Village will be able to repay \$287,500 of the local share through 0% interest loans over 20 years.
