

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-05-01

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RONYAK PAVING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$49,251.00 FOR THE ROAMING ROCK BOULEVARD PROJECT AND NOT DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined the need to have certain projects completed within the Village and that the Village Administrator has received a quote under the bid threshold contemplated under Ohio Revised Code but beyond the Village Administrator's spending authority under the local ordinances of the Village.


WHEREAS, the Village Council, via diligence of the Village Administrator, has received a bona fide, bonded, and appropriate quote from Ronyak Paving, Inc. for completion of said project in the sum of \$49,251.00


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, in the County of Ashtabula, State of Ohio, as follows:


SECTION 1. The Village Administrator and/or Mayor are hereby authorized to execute all necessary contracts and/or documents associated with bid and proposal Ronyak Paving, Inc. in the sum of \$49,251.00 for the Roaming Rock Boulevard Project.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is not deemed to be an emergency and shall take effect as prescribed by law.
