

ORDINANCE 637-06-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT WITH ELI AND MARY HOSTETLER AND WAIVE A SANITARY TAP-IN FEE TO HOSTETLER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Village has entered into an easement agreement to place a sanitary sewer line on property belonging to Eli and Mary Hostetler in exchange for waiving a sewer tap in fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio:

SECTION 1. Council herein approves the easement between the Village and Eli and Mary Hostetler, (see attached exhibit A) wherein they are to receive a waiver for one sanitary sewer tap in fee.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance for the health, safety and welfare of the Village for the reason that the easement is necessary to complete an important sanitary sewer project at Plum Creek; and this ordinance will take effect immediately upon passage.
