

ORDINANCE 757-02-2020 (amended 2002 4 6)

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING RULES FOR THE USE OF THE VILLAGE COMPOST SITE AND NOT DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Village Mayor, or her designee, is hereby authorized to issue Village residents a 24 hour key to access to the Village compost site for the purpose of depositing appropriate organic material for compost. To obtain ~~In return for such~~ a 24 hour key, the Village resident shall complete a form prescribed by the Mayor, demonstrate that they are a village resident, and deposit the same with the Mayor or her designee. ~~a valid Ohio drivers license showing that such person has an address in the Village of Roaming Shores. Upon the return of the key, the Mayor or designee shall return the drivers license to the resident.~~

SECTION 2. In lieu of a 24 hour access key, a village resident may lease from the Village a seasonal key to the Village compost site valid from January 1st to December 31st annually. The resident shall complete a form as prescribed by the Village Clerk-Treasurer and shall pay to the Clerk a fee of \$50.00.

SECTION 3. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any person to:

- a) Use the compost facility for any purpose than to deposit organic material exclusively from property the licensee owns and which is located within the Village of Roaming Shores
- b) To transfer either the seasonal or 24 hour access key to anyone for any purpose.
- c) To deposit any material other than vegetative material in the compost site.
- d) Fail to return a 24 hour key or seasonal pass upon its expiration and ten (10) days written notice to do so.

SECTION 4. Anyone found violating this ordinance may be denied access to the compost site and, for a subsequent offense, -and may be guilty of a minor misdemeanor and fined \$150.00.

SECTION 5. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6 This ordinance is not deemed to be an emergency and shall take effect thirty days after passage.
