

Special Village Council Meeting

May 18, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jennie D'Amicone. Roll Call was taken and the following members were present : Bob Cook, Ed Koziol, Duane Helms, Gary Meighen and Chris Plickert. Marlene Hocevar attended via zoom (video conferencing) as well as Clerk-Treasurer Leeann Moses .Unable to attend was Solicitor Kyle Smith.

Chris Plickert asked if Ordinance 762-05-20 could be read in its entirety. Clerk-Treasurer Leeann Moses read the Ordinance out loud.

Ordinance 762-05-20 : *Requiring the Use of Face Masks in the Village Hall (1st)*. Ed Koziol made a motion, seconded by Marlene Hocevar, to waive the three reading rule. Roll Call was taken and those voting in favor were Bob Cook, Duane Helms, Marlene Hocevar and Ed Koziol. Opposed were Gary Meighen and Chris Plickert. The motion failed. The Ordinance was read for the first reading.

Chris Plickert stated that he believes this Ordinance is unconstitutional and could open the Village up to a lawsuit, there are several pending around the state including one in Lake County. If you choose to wear a mask, do so. We should listen to the recommendation of our Solicitor and suggest that a mask be worn with a *please* and *thank you*.

VISITOR'S COMMENTS : *Justin Szalay* stated that with not all members using zoom, he is unable to know which members of Council are present. He asked what if people come to the Village Hall are there masks available? *Yes, there is*. He simply didn't understand how this all was going to work. *Chris Plickert* expressed his concern on the paper dispenser in the men's rest room facilities.

ADJOURN : A motion was made by Ed Koziol, seconded by Duane Helms, to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed with all in favor and Mayor D'Amicone adjourned the meeting.
